

14th International Eclogite Conference (IEC-14)

Invitation to Haüy's day "In the footsteps of René-Just Haüy" July 10th at Museum National d'Histoire Naturelle in Paris

GENERAL INFORMATION

PRESENTATION

Two centuries ago, in 1822, René-Just Haüy created the name "eclogite", meaning "chosen rock". To celebrate this bicentenary, as well as the 40th anniversary of the International Eclogite Conference (IEC), the usual syn-conference excursion of the IEC will be held exceptionally at Haüy's workplace in the *Muséum National d'Histoire Naturelle* (MNHN) in Paris, on the first day of IEC14, the 10th of July 2022.

The meeting is scheduled for July 10th at 10:30 at the auditorium of the *Grande Galerie de l'Évolution* (access: 36 Rue Geoffroy-Saint-Hilaire, Paris: Fig. 1, n°1). As this Gallery is also opened to the public, you will have to follow a specific procedure in order not to pay and to respect the security measures (see below "practical information"). After the talks, devoted to the history of the eclogites and the IEC (see "schedule", below), we will go to the nearby *Galerie de Minéralogie* (Fig. 1, n°3) for a lunch buffet, around an exhibition devoted to eclogites and high-pressure rocks. In the afternoon, we propose you a short walk "from Haüy's workplace to Curie's laboratory" (Fig. 1, n°4&5).

A shuttle will be waiting for you at 3:40 p.m. at 57 Rue Cuvier (Fig. 1, n°6) to take you to Paris-Gare de Lyon station, where, whatever happens, we have to catch a train to Lyon at 4:58 p.m. (tickets already booked). Arrival at Lyon Part Dieu station is scheduled for 6:56 p.m.

Due to various security and time constraints, we ask that you read the recommendations below carefully and keep this circular with you.

PRACTICAL INFORMATION

ENTRANCE AT THE NATURAL HISTORY MUSEUM

You must enter the *Muséum National d'Histoire Naturelle* via the entrance at 36 rue Geoffroy Saint-Hillarie (lat. 48.84157°N; long. 2.35596°E; Fig. 1, n°1). The *Grande Galerie de l'Évolution* is immediately on your left (Fig. 1, n°2).

To enter the building, you will have to **show this circular** which has the value of an invitation. You will also have to **wear a mask** (against Covid) and **not bring your luggage**. We therefore advise you to **leave your luggage at your hotel** if it is not far away, or deposit it before **at the left-luggage office at Paris-Gare de Lyon** station, where you can collect it earlier catching the train (see below).

LEFT-LUGGAGE OFFICE AT PARIS-GARE DE LYON STATION




Figure 2: Paris-Gare de Lyon station

We strongly advise against bringing your luggage to the MNHN, otherwise you will have to queue, pay the entrance ticket and leave your luggage in the cloakroom. If you cannot leave it at your hotel, we recommend you to use the left-luggage office at Paris-Gare de Lyon Station (20 mins walk or 6 mins by bus 24 from the MNHN), located on level -1 (see Fig. 2 below). You can find it in the station by following the signs "Consigne; left-luggage; deposito bagagli". Credit cards are not accepted, but a coin machine can convert your banknotes into coins; the deposit ticket is necessary to collect your luggage. Another left-luggage office is available at Austerlitz station, closer to the Museum, or at other locations (*e.g.*, https://radicalstorage.com/luggage-storage/paris).

GETTING THE TRAIN AT PARIS-GARE DE LYON STATION

Whether or not you take the shuttle, we shall meet at 4 p.m. at meeting point n°5 ("Point de rencontre") in Paris-Gare de Lyon station (Fig. 2). We will then all have to go together to the boarding platform of train "TGV INOUI 6687". Seats are booked for us in carriage 5 (seats n° 41-48, 51-58, 61, 62, 65, 66, 68, 71, 74, 75, 78, 83, 84, 87, 88, 91-98, 101-108) and carriage 6 (22-28, 31-38). Please, **don't be late because we have to pass the ticket barrier altogether**. The train will leave at 4:58 p.m. and arrive at 6:56 p.m. in Lyon (Part Dieu station).

- 9- Towards Paris-Gare de Lyon station (700 m; 15 mins walk).
